### First call for abstracts

The Cape Peninsula University of Technology (CPUT), The University of the Western Cape (UWC), the University of Cape Town (UCT) and Stellenbosch University (SU) will be hosting the National colloquium on Extended Curriculum Programmes (ECPs) in Stellenbosch in 2020. The conference take place on 25 and 25 August with a pre-conference workshop on 24 August.

You are hereby invited to submit an abstract for this colloquium. Submissions can be made in either the Research-based or Innovation-based track.

#### **Theme: Promoting Scholarship in ECP**

#### **Sub-themes:**

- Multilingualism - Encouraging students to use their mother tongue to access knowledge
- How does multimodality work to contribute to socially just pedagogies and making knowledge more accessible in extended curriculum programmes?
- How does casualisation and precarity affect the academics who teach on the extended curriculum programmes and their ability to become scholarly in their teaching and research?
- How might scholarship of teaching and learning and inquiry-focused learning contribute to ECP students becoming producers rather than receivers of knowledge?
- How might indigenous knowledges be incorporated into extended curriculum programmes?
- How might decolonising the curriculum contribute to the scholarship of teaching and learning?
- Student data analytics - how can effective tracking and monitoring of ECP students contribute to scholarship?
- What pedagogical practices would contribute to students and academics becoming scholars?

*\*Please register and pay for the conference by **17 July 2020** in order to be included in the programme.*

#### **Guidelines**

Abstracts should be a maximum of 500 words (excluding title and author information).

## Criteria for the abstract

There are two types of abstracts: **Research** and **Innovation**. The following **must** be included in the abstract type you select, in the order as listed below:

<b>Research</b>	<b>Innovation</b>
Background, rationale, purpose	Background, context, purpose
Research question(s)	Particular interest/focus of presentation
Theoretical framing and literature review	Description of work done
Methods	Links to similar work
<b>Implications:</b> How the work adds to the field, relevance for other contexts, additional areas for further research	<b>Implications:</b> Take-home messages, e.g. might be relevant or useful in another context, or opens additional areas for further exploration/research
Originality or significance of research	Value to fellow practitioners
Results or conclusions from findings	Conclusions

### General criteria

- The title of the presentation must be no longer than 10 words.
- The abstract must be between 400 and 500 words.
- The abstract must be language edited before it is submitted.
- The abstract should contain in-text references (author date), but a reference list is not required.
- The abstract should be understandable to a broad spectrum of readers.
- The abstract must be submitted by 29 May 2020.

Once your abstract has been accepted, you will receive an email via the Conference Portal that will indicate that your abstract was accepted for the ECP colloquium.

### How to submit an abstract/contribution

**You first need to register as a user for this conference at <https://www.conftool.net/ncoecp2020/>**

Then **do the following:**

1. Log in at the above address using the access details created during the registration process.
2. Click on **Your Submissions**.
3. Choose either **Research** or **Innovation**.
4. Complete the necessary fields.
5. Click on **Proceed and Complete submission**.

Then a screen will appear showing the new submission created with the details. You will also receive an e-mail confirming your submission.
